Writing With Alternative Pencils CD

Writing is typically a challenge for students with speech, sensory and motor difficulties, resulting in limited, if any opportunities to write. Thus, a variety of alternative pencils have been developed to help educators find pencils that work for their students.

This CD consists of 6 alternative pencils. Each pencil has been developed to support different students' sensory and physical abilities in manipulating the alphabet. Each pencil is accompanied by a brief guide, which includes teaching strategies, sample goals, writing activities and actual student writing samples. Printable files and directions for making each of these pencils have also been included. Try the different writing activities and see which alternative pencil works the best for your student! Players and utilities have also been included.
